Term	Definition
MAC	The Michigan Association of Counties (MAC) was formed in 1898 to advocate for the interests of Michigan's county governments. Over the past 100 years, MAC has evolved into a highly respected organization that offers the full spectrum of association services that distribute important public information to its members.
MACSC	The Michigan Association of Counties Service Corporation (MACSC) was established in 1986 to provide services to MAC members through the development and maintenance of a variety of programs and services.
MCWCF	The Michigan Counties Workers' Compensation Fund was formed in 1979 to provide workers' compensation insurance to our members while maintaining a safe, secure work environment, in addition to saving the county money.
MAC Annual Conference	MAC's annual conference location varies from year to year, but is held in September.
MAC Legislative Conference	MAC's Legislative Conference is held in Lansing annually in March/April.
MAC ETP	MAC's Education and Training Program provides practical, technical, legal, and legislative expertise on a wide range of topics fundamental to county operations.
